

WEEE Statement

This letter is to advise that Red Lion has reviewed the requirements of Directive 2012/19/EU regarding waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE). The following information is being provided for use when questions arise regarding Red Lion and WEEE “producer” definitions and product marking.

The definition of producer under the WEEE Directive includes three descriptions of “producer” including “any person who imports or exports electrical or electronic equipment on a professional basis into a member state.” When the WEEE Directive came about a few years ago, the Red Lion EU distributor partners all registered as producers, and it was determined that Red Lion did not need to register. So, while Red Lion is the manufacturer of the device, for WEEE purposes, Red Lion distributors are the registered producers of what they buy and sell from Red Lion.

Red Lion does not need to be registered to mark a product with the WEEE Wheelie Bin symbol. The marking simply identifies an item as being Electrical Equipment (EE) and tells the end user that the item should be recycled and not just tossed in a wheelie bin.
