The once successful DLC – Dual Loop Controller, now a 15 year-old design, continues to be displaced by Red Lion's newer Modular Controller series. That, combined with several parts obsolescence issues, has forced us to discontinue the models that support DeviceNet and DH-485.

With immediate effect, the following part numbers have been discontinued:

For the avoidance of doubt, the standard DLCs equipped with Modbus communications are NOT affected by the parts issue. These models have recently undergone a significant redesign in order to maintain supply for the foreseeable future. Please note that the following models are NOT affected by the parts issue:
